**Minutes from the September meeting**

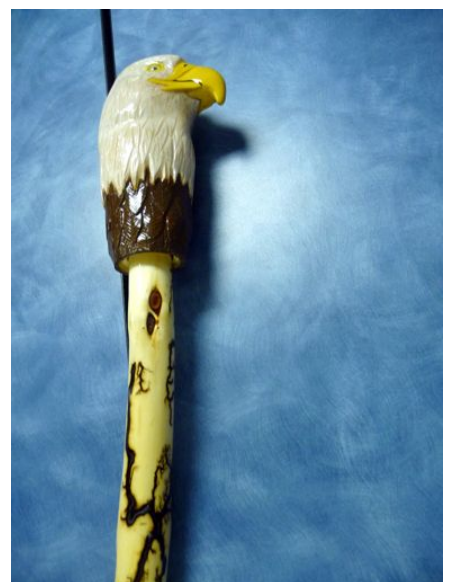
